

CBF Men's Dove Hunt 2010

Date: September 17th, 18th, and 19th, 2010

Cost: \$125/person/shooting day (includes bed, food, and hunting).
If you hunt Friday afternoon, you pay for that day.

Location: Weinert, TX (North of Haskell which is North of Abilene) (See directions below)
3 ½ hour drive

Schedule:

- Arrive Weinert, TX Friday, 9/17 approx. 8:00 p.m. (Eat dinner on the road)
- Friday night sleep - bed provided
- Saturday breakfast provided
- **Safety Talk (Everyone needs to attend)**
- Saturday morning Hunt, shoot clays pigeons if no birds (optional)
- Saturday lunch provided
- Saturday afternoon Hunt
- Saturday night dinner provided
- Saturday night sleep (even better)- bed provided
- Sunday breakfast provided
- Sunday (Sunrise Worship Service)
- Sunday morning Hunt
- Sunday lunch provided (if we want it..we will discuss)
- Depart at your leisure

Accommodations:

- Rough old House and Rough old Mobile Home in downtown Weinert, TX
- We can accommodate 30 people maximum.

Directions to Weinert, TX

You've got two options: Interstate I-20 or Hwy 380. (I prefer the Hwy 380 route, but I-20 route is more "foolproof".)

- ***I-20 West to Abilene, TX then Hwy -277 North to Weinert, TX***

- Leave Coppel and take I-30 West (toward Weatherford, TX) however you think best.
Option #1: Take Hwy 121 and go thru down town Fort Worth and hit I-30 west.
Option #2: You can take North Loop 820 to I-30 West. I-30 will become I -20 West.

- Once on I-20 travel west until you get to Abilene, TX.... (A long way +/- 135 miles!)

- In Abilene take the Hwy 277 North exit (May be called Hwy 277/83 north). This exit will be on the west side of Abilene.

- Stay on Hwy 277 North approx. 70 miles to Weinert. You will go thru Anson, TX, Stamford, TX, and Haskell, TX. Weinert is approximately 12 miles north of Haskell (set your odometer).

- **WATCH FOR WEINERT, TX!! YOU CAN MISS IT!!** As you approach the south side of Weinert the road forks, take the two lane fork to the right onto **Business 277** into Weinert. If it's still daylight there is a small pond in the fork of the road that has a duck decoy in it!

- In Weinert, TX look first for the Post Office (very small) somewhere behind this very small Post Office is K&L Outdoors. You will see 2 mobile homes, an old house and a small white metal building and a sign that says K&L Outdoors on the side of the building. You have arrived at K&L Outdoors (ask for Kyle White if you get lost in Weinert). He is the owner of K&L Outdoors and everyone around knows Kyle. Kyle's mobile number is 940-256-5005.

Hwy 380 Option:

- Take Hwy 114 West to Hwy 287/81 North to Decatur, TX
- In Decatur take Hwy 380 West all the way from to Haskell, TX (Pay attention to 380 West as it has several weird turns)
- In Haskell, TX Hwy 277 North to Weinert, TX. Weinert, TX is approximately 12 miles north of Haskell (set your odometer).
- Fill up with gas in Haskell, TX (or on 380); this might be your last easy opportunity for gas for a couple of days
- **WATCH FOR WEINERT, TX!! YOU CAN MISS IT!!** As you approach the south side of Weinert the road forks, take the two lane fork to the right onto **Business 277** into Weinert. If it's still daylight there is a small pond in the fork of the road that has a duck decoy in it!
- In Weinert, TX look first for the Post Office (very small) somewhere behind this very small Post Office is K&L Outdoors. 7. Bug Spray
8. Camo Ball Hat
9. Camo shirt
10. Camo or Brown pants
11. Comfortable dove stool or chair
12. Camo Bird/Shell vest
13. Small Game hunting license
14. Boots
15. Sun Glasses (For sun and eye protection)
16. Filet Knife (if you have one..otherwise...don't buy one...we will have another job for you!)
17. Heavy Duty Scissors (to clean birds..don't buy one...we will have another job for you to!)
18. Cooler, Water, Soft Drinks, Ice (Assign people to bring these items)
19. Snacks provided (Assign people to bring snacks for the field)
20. Large Heavy Duty garbage bags (Assign)
21. Skeet Thrower (Burt Odom)
22. Skeet (Burt Odom)
23. A Good Attitude
